Stringy Brae has had significant show success of late, specially with its 2004 vintage. The 2005 has a fairly full mid-yellow colour and creamy- smooth, lemon-butter, straw and cashew aromas, while the taste is somewhat straightforward, dry and smooth. Andrew Caillard liked the mineral, slate flavours and 'cutting acidity'; Sophie Otton went for its lemongrass aroma and cleansing mineral acidity.

The 2002 Stringy Brae Shiraz aptly named 'Hannah's High Maintenance Shiraz' by staff is a vibrant red wine made from grapes grown in north-south run on quite hilly terrain, that is known to be difficult. The Shiraz is heady and peppery, the perfect accompaniment at dinner. From the same vintage comes the new release Cabernet Sauvignon, which is well structured and quietly self-assured. This one has classical tones that reveal their complexity slowly. A few years on, it will have a seductive long finish.
